Richard graduated from University of Wisconsin, Madison, USA, with a degree in English Literature and Creative Writing. He has published three novels: *Pathfinders of Love* (1999), *Heart of the Night* (2000), and the *Rainmaker's Daughter* (2004).

According to novel *Heart of the Night*, this novel tell the story of Darius, a young man from Jakarta, Indonesia. Darius was perfectly comfortable living his world of occasional inanities. He was the like a king of ease and complacency. Nothing could have ruffled his existence until one faethful night when thing accountably turned complicated. Without the reason, his girlfriend he so dearly loved left him, and the one good friend. ## **THEORITICAL REVIEWS**

### **1. The Concept of Literature**

Literature is a way of express thoughts, ideas, and thoughts with the descriptions of experience. Luigi (1976:112) said that “Literature is a slice of life that has been given direction and meaning, an artistic interpretation of the world according to the percipient’s point of views”. Frequently, the text that makes up an artistic literature is novel, poem, poetry, drama, etc.

Wallek and Warren (1963:94) stated that literature represents life, and life is, in large measure, a social reality, even though the natural world and the inner of subjective world of individual has also been object of literary imitation.

Literature is a written form which expose the idea in art way. In Oxford Advanced Learner’s Dictionary (1995:687) said that “Literature is writings that are valued as works of art, especially fiction, drama and poetry (in contrast with technical books and newspaper, magazines, etc)”. If follow the definition, it tells us that the literature is not focusing on the literary work only, but every kind of writing is called as literature. But, have to classify into the specific meaning of literature since literature has many definitions, it just how to define it. Here, the writer intends to give the specific definition of literature.

Fokkema and Elrud (1977:78),theory of analysis the writter sociological approaches. Sociological approach is used to analyze the influence of social attitude. According to Kennedy (1983:66), literature can be divided into three kinds. Those three kinds were explained in detailed as follows:

- a. Drama is different from a work of fiction in another essential, a play is not only addressed to solitary reader but also a group of people seated together in a theater. It is the same with the statement that axpressed by Kennedy (1983:66). He say that a play is a work of story telling in which actors represent yhe character.

- b. Poetry is the result of literary art and if it is compared with the other of literary works, poetry is more connotative because the languages has many possible meanings that is why some readers of poem feel difficult in understanding its meaning so even its message.
- c. Prose is a form of language that has no formal. It applies a natural flow of speech, and ordinary grammatical structure, such as in the case of traditional poetry. The types of prose can be divided into the following explanation: first, according to Singleton & Millet (1966:1194) states that novel is a prose fiction of considerable length showing characters in action and capable af greater complexity both character and plot than the story. Second, novella is a work written, fictional, narrative prose normally longer than a short story but shorter than a novel. Finally, short story is consist from of prose fiction, has received less attention from literary scholars than the novel.

The explanation above can be concluded that literature deals with an effort to reveal ideas and expression of trivial phenomenon, an author has in a form of literature, either fiction such a romance novel or other forms of literature.

## 2. The Concept of Novel

Etymology, word ‘**Novel**’ derives from the italian *novella* for “new”, “news”, or “short story of something new”, itself from the latin *novella*, a singular noun use of the neuter plural of *Novellus*, diminutive of *novus*, meaning “new” most European languages have preserved the term “romance” for extended narratives.

According to Singleton & Millet in Subhan (2006:11) states that novel is prose fiction of considerable length showing characters in action and capable of greater complexity both character and plot than the story.

In addition, Koesnobroto (1988:18) says that the fill length of a novel may consist of over 10.000 words, contains a number of characters, some of them are fully developed, have more incidents, scenes or episodes, have a number of settings, and may take place in a long span of time. It may have more than one theme, may have both minor and mayor crises (conflict), and climaxes.

Novel is a kind of imaginative literature which belongs to narrative fiction. The literature of imaginations always present experience by a fictitious presentation of persons, idea, and events. In novel, all events or ideas are almost the same with the reality. The early “novel” contrasting the early “romance” was basically any story told for its spectacular or revealing incidents. The original environment-living on with the typical frame setting was the entertaining conversation.

The novel proved to be a medium for a communication both intimate (novel can be read privately whereas plays are always a public event) and public (novels are published and thus become a matter touching the public, if not the nation, and its vital interest), a medium of a personal point of view which can get the world into its view. The author creates character, plot, and setting which is familiar to the reader's in order to make them easily understand the point of view of the novel, comprehend and enjoy the story that the author serves. Novel has a complex plot, many characters, complex theme, various atmospheres and setting. It means that a novel has broad dimension which includes a lot of characters, scenes, episodes, a complex plot, and having more than 100.000 words.

### **3. Kinds of Novel**

According to Koesnosoebroto (1985:11) There are some kinds of novel that found in contemporary publishing:

#### **a. Action – adventure**

Action-adventure fiction, traditionally (but not exclusively) aimed at male readers, features physical action and violence, often around a quest or military style mission set in exotic or forbidding locales such as jungles, deserts, or mountains.

#### **b. Crime**

Crime fiction, centered on criminal enterprise, are told from the point of view of the perpetrators. They range in tone from lighthearted “caper” stories to darker plots involving organized crime or incarcerated convicts.

#### **c. Detective**

Detective fiction has become almost synonymous with mystery. These stories relate the solving of a crime, usually one or more murders, by a protagonist who may or may not be a professional investigator. This large, popular genre has many subgenres, reflecting differences in tone, character, and it always contains criminal and detective settings.

#### **d. Fantasy**

Fantasy fictions features stories set in fanciful, invented worlds, an alternative and more fanciful version of our own world, or in a legendary, mythic past. Fantasy fiction stories generally involve magic, mystical elements, or supernatural creatures. The genre's relatively loose definition means includes a large number of works in style ranging from pseudo-mythological epics to more deliberatory modern works, and includes works which also fall under other genre, such as horror fiction, comedy, action-adventure or romance.

#### **e. Horror**

Horror fiction aims to evoke some combination of fear, fascination, and revulsion in its readers. This genre, like others, continues to develop, recently moving away from stories with a religious or supernatural basis to ones making use of medical or psychological ideologies.

f. Mystery

Mystery fiction, technically involving stories in which characters try to discover a vital piece of information which is kept hidden until the climax, is now considered by many people almost a synonym for detective fiction. The standard novel stocked in the mystery section of bookstores is a whodunit.

g. Romance

Romance is currently the largest and best selling fiction genre in North America. It has produced a wide array of subgenres, the majority of which feature the mutual attraction and love of a man and a woman as the main plot, and have a happy ending. This genre, much like fantasy fiction, is broad enough in definition that it is easily and commonly seen combined with other genres, such as comedy, fantasy fiction, realistic fiction, or action adventure.

#### **4. Character and Characterization**

Character is the representation of a person in a narrative or dramatic work of art such as novel, play or film. It is revealed by how the character responds to conflict, by his or her dialogue, and through description.

Koesnosoebroto(1985:13) mention that there are two kind of characters protagonist and antagonist. In tradition fiction the protagonist is also hero and heroin, an admirable character that embodies widely accepted strenghts and virtues who is morally good. The other one is antagonist. The readers dislike this character because of his bad moral which he has such as cruel. He is called antagonist because he is oposite to protagonist.

Peck and Coyle (1989:79) stated that the people in a play darama, film are referred to as characters. Character is the person in the literary work or the personality of such a figure sentimental lover, or whatever. If analyze a character, will discover that the persons who involved in novel have stamped themselves with certain predominant traits and motives that distinguish him from another character.

In addition DiYanni(2000:745) “characters bring plays to life.” First and last become absorbed in the characters: how they look and what their appearance tells us about them; what

they say and what their manner of saying expresses; what they do and how their actions reveal who they are and what they represent. The writer may come to know them and respond to them in ways we come to know and respond to actual people, all the while realizing that characters are literary imitations of human beings.

Characters in the first sense are sometime classified as either “flat” or “round”. Flat is one dimensional and round is fully realized or complex. The main character in fiction or in play is called protagonist, in many stories an important opponent pitted against him, it was called the antagonist who provides opposition. Traditionally, the protagonist is also the hero, heroine or the survivor. An admirable character that embodies widely accepted strengths, virtues, and good morality. “Characterization is the author’s way of describing his characters in a literary work; or it is the author’s means of differentiating one character to another.”

#### a. Main Character

According to Koesnosoebroto (1988:67) character divided into parts: Main character and Minor character. Main character or major character in a story is generally known as the protagonist and the character who opposes him or her is antagonist. Because round or main character usually play a major role in a story, main characters are often called the hero or heroine. Many major characters are anything but heroic, however, and it is therefore preferable to use the more neutral word protagonist.

#### b. Minor Character

Minor characters are the people in story who are not the main point of the story (for instances, not the person who the story is happening to), but still interact with or grab the attention of the main characters. In contrast, flat character or minor character do not grow. They remain the same because they may be stupid or insensitive or lacking knowledge or insight. They are static because they end where they begin. But minor characters are not therefore worthless, for they usually highlight the development of the main character.

Characterization is the author’s way of describing his characters in a literary work; or it is the author’s means of differentiating one character to another. The characteristics of *Darius* the main protagonist, narrator of the novel, the narrator and protagonist; an artist in Indonesia. Darius has the perfectly live. He was unsullied king of ease and complacency. But, his world has changed when his girlfriend without reason left him. *Darius* is the central figure in *heart of the Night* the main protagonist narrator of the novel.

### 5. Social Attitude

Social attitude is an acquired tendency to evaluate social things in specific way. According to Schwarz and Bohner (2001:2), attitude is a mental and neural state of readiness, organized through experience, exerting a directive and dynamic influence upon the individual's response to all objects and situations with which it is related. In addition Krech and Crutchfield (1948:152) states that an attitude can be defined as an enduring organization of motivational, emotional, perceptual and cognitive process with respect to some aspect of the individual's world. Social attitudes has three main components, namely;

- 1) Emotional component is the feeling experienced on evaluation of a particular entity.
- 2) Cognitive components implies thought and beliefs toward the subjects.
- 3) Behaviour components conduct the result from a social attitude.

An individual with an explicit attitude is aware of it and how it dictates his behaviour and beliefs. On the other hand, a person may not be conscious of his implicit attitude, although it still may influence his beliefs and behaviour. People pick social attitudes from personal experiences or observation. Likewise, social roles and norms can dictate formation of attitudes. Social roles determine the behaviour an individual occupying a particular position or context in the society is expected to demonstrate, while social norms define the conduct that's acceptable to the society. However, social attitude does not always lead to specific behavior. For example, someone may favor policies of a specific politician but fail to turn out to vote. Attitudes can be dropped the same way they're learned.

## **6. Sociological Approach**

Sociological approach has spoken by many people belonging to specialist the theory of literature. According to Damono in Subhan (2006:81), sociological approach is a new knowledge in literature, sociological approach is a study context of the social author, and sociological approach also as exemplar of the society, and the function of sociological approach.

According to Wallek and Warren (1965:84), sociological approach can be divided into three kinds, namely; the author sociology, universe sociology, and the reader sociology. But in this study the writer focused on universe sociology.

- a. Universe sociology is a kind of sociological approach that explain about the world, society, or realitas of social that taken by a literary work.

Related with the research of literature, Agust Nigro in Subhan (2006:81), explain that a researcher of literature must fuse some approaches for the research of literature, the text refer to the extrinsic element of literature. in addition, Kenedy and Gioia (1995:1790), states that sociological approach is examines literature in the cultural, economic and political



context in which is written or received, exploring the relationships between the artist and society. Sometimes it examines the artist's society to better understand the author's literary works, other times, it may examine the representation of such societal elements within the literature itself.

Sociological approach is an important thing in literature research. sociological approach give wide materials, namely; the author sociology, the universe sociology, and the reader sociology. Beside that, sociological approach make possible to the researcher to use this approaches to the other knowledge, such as economy, history, anthropology, politic, culture, etc.

According to his personal website (<http://richardoh.net>) since he started writing in 1998, Richard has completed three novels and two films. He also cofounded the Khatulistiwa Literary Award, established in 2001 in Collaboration with Takeshi Ichiki of Plaza Senayan, and even founded his own chain of bookstores, QB World Books. Richard knows that it takes a lot of dedication and hard work to publish a book. After studying English Literature and Creative Writing, it took at least 15 years for him to work up the courage to complete his first novel. Until then, Richard had been working as an advertising copywriter in Jakarta. But when his own words finally started to flow from his pen, there was no stopping him.

It was the riots in Jakarta in May 1998 that finally kicked Richard into gear with his writing. Propelled forward by the country's transformation at that time, Richard completed his first book, "Pathfinders of Love", in only nine months.
